

DRINKING WATER NOTICE

Microcystins monitoring requirements not met for Washington Court House public water system

We are required to monitor your drinking water for specific contaminants on a regular basis. Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not our drinking water meets health standards. During the weeks of 6/12/22-6/25/22 we did not monitor for microcystins and therefore cannot be sure of the quality of our drinking water during that time.

What Should I Do?

This notice is to inform you that WASHINGTON COURT HOUSE public water system did not monitor, and report results for the presence of microcystins in the public drinking water system during the weeks of 6/12/22-6/25/22 monitoring period, as required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency. You do not need to take any action in response to this notice.

What is being done?

Upon being notified of this violation, the water supply was required to have the drinking water analyzed for total microcystins according to their current monitoring schedule. The water supplier will take steps to ensure that adequate monitoring will be performed in the future.
