With winter weather expected this weekend, the Washington Court House Service Department has completed preparations for the incoming snow. The snowfall that is possible will present a challenge, but our team is ready to respond.

For the safety of both the public and our employees, snow-plow drivers will be rotated throughout the event. This ensures that our crews remain alert and able to operate equipment safely under difficult conditions.

Residents are reminded that when plows are working, snow will naturally be pushed toward the sides of the street (the exception is the confined space of downtown). If you are able, please park off the street — your vehicle will avoid being packed in with snow, and it makes plowing a little easier.

A number of our street-crew members, along with employees from other departments assisting them, are younger and have not experienced the amount of snow that is forecast. These folks are our people; they have enthusiasm, they want to work, and they care about you.

The news cycle is now all day long, every day. Constant reminders about weather events can build anxiety. All of us need to calmly think about what we need for the weekend. Remember: your stress does not melt snow. You have experienced snow before, and you will experience snow again.

Our main routes will receive priority attention. This storm will be a challenge, but it is a challenge we will meet with patience, common sense, and a strong community spirit.
